At the end of year 1, each child takes part in a phonics screening check, assessing how well children are able to decode words using phonics. If children do not reach the required standard, they are re-tested in year 2.

Each child completes SATS papers in reading, maths and GPS (Grammar, punctuation and spelling). A teacher assessment is given for writing, based on a portfolio of written work.
