11+ 2022 Entry

As your child is in year 5, you may wish to consider whether or not they sit the 11+ exam. Please find below information regarding The Consortium of Selective Schools in Essex (CSSE) procedure.

Registration for the 11+ exam will be from the 18th May up to and including the 2nd July.

CSSE schools will hold open days/evenings during June and July.

Registering your child for CSSE 11+

- Registration will commence on the **18th May** via www.csse.org.uk
- The tests will take place on **Saturday 18th September**

The closing date is 2nd July

Test Information

English Paper

The English paper will comprise:

- Comprehension, grammar and vocabulary questions
- Two pieces of continuous writing
- Applied reasoning (literacy/verbal)
- The paper will last 1 hour, with an additional 10 minutes reading time, and will be worth 60 marks in total.

Mathematics Paper

The Mathematics paper will comprise:

- Questions consistent with the National Curriculum
