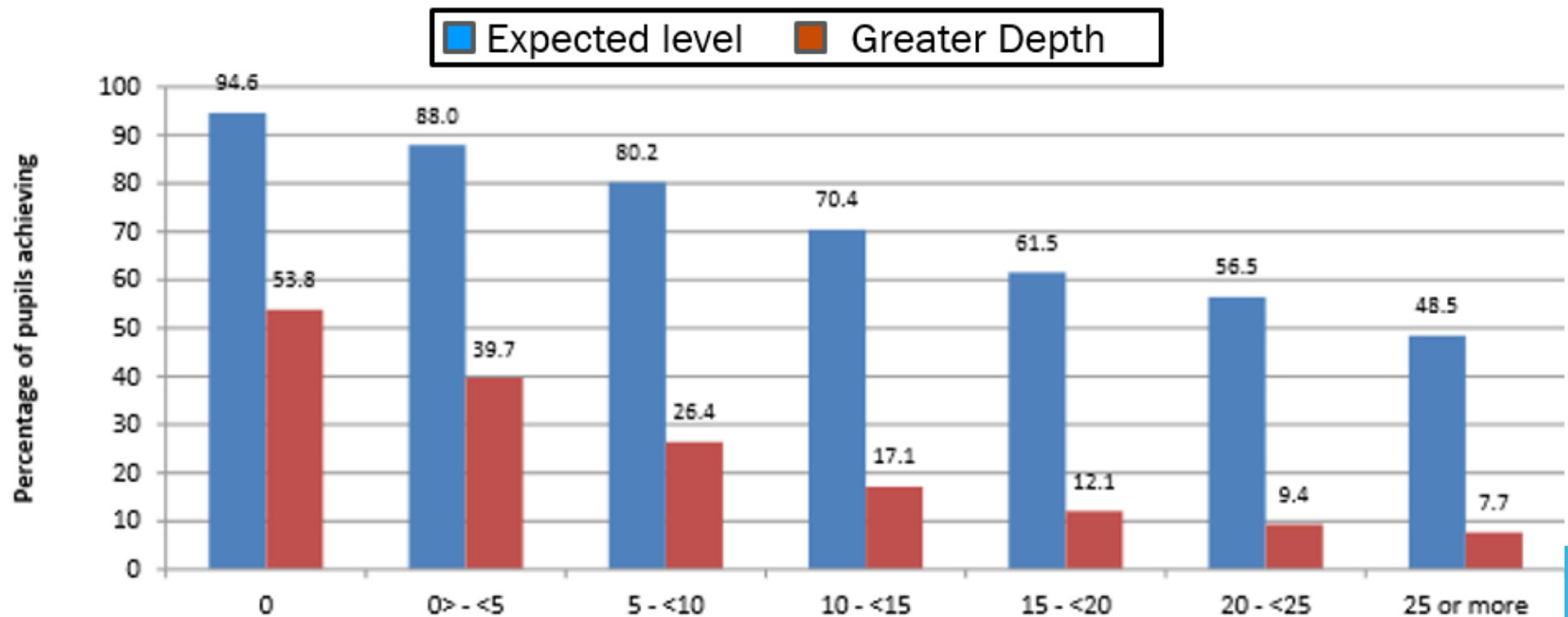

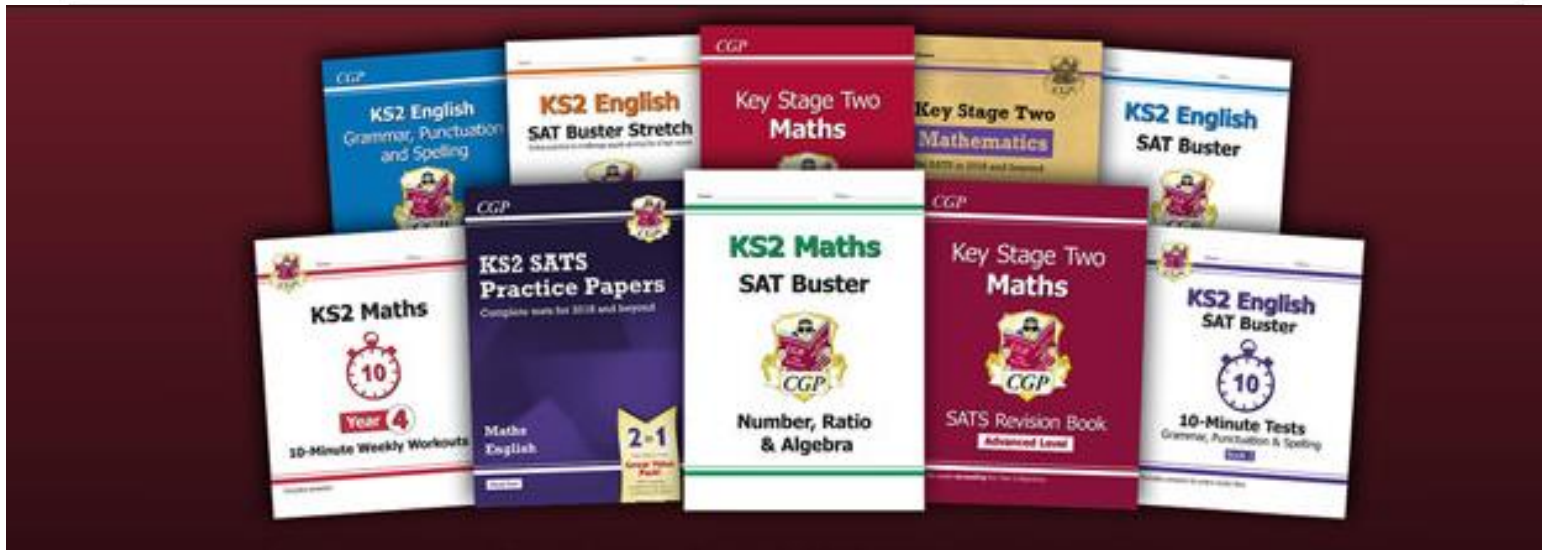

❖ Scores in the 10<sup>th</sup> percentile on standardized tests.

# SATS

Children are tested in:

- Reading
- Grammar and punctuation
- Spelling
- Arithmetic
- Maths (Reasoning A and Reasoning B)

Children are expected to reach the national curriculum expectations for year 6.

These are reported as 'expected', 'above expected' and 'below expected' but school will report to you how children are moving towards these throughout the year.

There is no additional test for the higher levels. This will be incorporated into the main tests, so we still expect many children to exceed the average expectations.

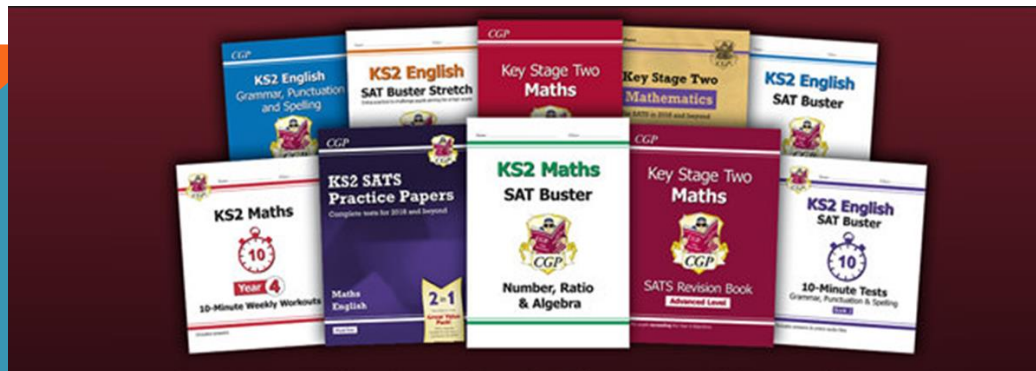
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# PREPARATION FOR SATS

## Welcome to the Essex Education Portal

Once logged in to the portal you will be able to submit and view applications for Free Early Education Entitlement for Two Year Olds and School Admissions.

### PLEASE NOTE:

**The secondary admissions round (for Year 7 in September 2022) will open on the 10th September 2021 and the closing date for applications is the 31st October 2021.**

**The primary admission round (for Reception in September 2022) will open on the 8th November 2021 and the closing date for applications is the 15th January 2022.**

**The junior admission round (for infant to junior, year 2 to 3, transfer in September 2022) will open on the 8th November 2021 and the closing date for applications is the 15th January 2022.**

Two ways to apply- complete a printed application form or apply online.

Choose four schools, in order of preference. Check the school's admissions criteria (they differ between each school- each school's policy should be on their website)

Include grammar schools if your child has completed/is taking the 11+.

Use all four options.

Ensure all personal information is accurate and inform the local authority if it changes before the offer date as this can affect the process.
