Head Teacher's Message

Dear families,

I hope you had a lovely weekend.

Reception Families – Thank you!

Across last week we saw many of our Reception families join us for some planting in their outside area where the Reception children learn and play. Thank you to all the families that join in on these planting events daily; the outside area looks wonderful after everyone's efforts. We are looking forward to the children taking great care of those winter flowering pansies and other plants and flowers by continuing to care and respect their outside learning space.

Mini London Marathon – 2.6 miles

Our school is taking part in the Mini London Marathon. Many of you may be aware the actual London Marathon took place at the start of October, as did the Chelmsford Half Marathon. For the Mini London Marathon all our children are running 2.6 miles each, up until the 22nd October, in school. The children are doing a bit each week to accumulate the 2.6 miles in total.

Clubs Are Starting

We are relaunching school clubs after a long period whereby such activities were not permitted during the height of COVID-19. Clubs will run for a shorter period of 4 weeks after half term as part of our initial relaunch. There will be no charge for clubs.

You will shortly be receiving a 'clubs letter' inviting you to sign your child up for a club if you wish. We are running clubs before school, at lunchtime and after school; with plenty of choices and activity. The places available in each club will be smaller to start with, yet they will be increased after Christmas when we roll out a new set of clubs and reopen the application process for

the Spring Term. The children were very excited to hear this in our assembly last week!

Educational Visits

We have started to book and attend educational visits again. Last week a group of our girls attended a Science Enrichment Day at the Chelmsford County High School. The children who attended got a taste of the science to come when they move to secondary school; The 'Fizz, Bang, Pop!' event was hosted by the Science and Computer Science departments at the school and was a day full of fun scientific activities.

Fire Safety Assembly

This week we are logging on to a Fireworks and Halloween Safety assembly presented by Essex Fire Service. We are entering the times of the season whereby we have to consider how to stay safe around fireworks and when it is much darker in our communities and for community events. The children will be logging in with their class this Wednesday to hear the important safety messages – please ask them about this.
