Age Appropriate Internet Safety

Children are always very keen to engage with the latest trends, such as popular TV shows, music and games. We ask that you continue to be aware and monitor what your children are watching on TV or streaming services such as Netflix in addition to what games they are playing as we have had an increase in the number of children talking about or acting out parts of a popular show for audiences 12/15+. We would suggest you speak to your children about what they like to watch/play and encourage them to find age appropriate alternatives. Please research what they are talking about and make sure you are reassured that it is age appropriate. Talking to your child if their choice is appropriate and

sharing why will support them to understand. Please do get in touch with us if we can be of any help, we will continue to teach your children about safety, both online and offline, and how to respond if they access material that is not age appropriate or upsets them.

The <u>National Online Safety</u> website has guides for parents about some of the current trends your child may be speaking about as well as some handy quick fixes to manage age appropriate content on your devices.


