Christmas Performance – Friday 10th December

Please join us for our outdoor Christmas Carol Concert this Friday 10th December. The performance will start at 4.30pm and everyone will be singing. Some children will be performing and speaking and will have had additional letters detailing their arrival times. Reverend Roddy will be joining us and the Friends of Trinity will be selling drinks and mince pies for you while you join in with our festive performances.

Christmas Jumper Day – Save The Children Charity Appeal

Remember to wear your best festive Christmas jumper on Friday 10th December too, as we are supporting Save The Children's Christmas Jumper Day Appeal. Your child can donate £1 to wear their Christmas jumper. Children are able to wear non-school uniform with their Christmas jumper.

Winter Layers

Please make sure your child has clothing appropriate for the weather. The temperature is dropping and we are maintaining good ventilation in school to support our COVID reduction risk assessment, this means that your child may need additional base layers to stay warm and a suitable waterproof, outdoor coat to stay dry.

This is especially important tomorrow, when Years 1 to 6 will be off to the Pantomime.

Santa Fun Run – Raise Money and dress as Santa (a Santa hat is just fine!)

Information about the Santa Fun Run and the sponsor form went home with every child at the start of the week. Your child will be running dressed as Santa, to raise money for the Friends of Trinity. Please sponsor your child to do their run, they will need to bring their sponsorship money back to school in the New Year; by Friday 7th January please.

Your child will be running 10 laps of the playground in EYFS and KS1, or 15 laps if they are in KS2!

The Santa Run dates for each class are as follows (remember your hat!):

- **Monday 13th December—Diamond, Amethyst, Ruby, Emerald and Turquoise**
- **Tuesday 14th December—Crystal, Sapphire, Moonstone, Topaz, Opal, Jet and Jade**

Unfortunately we are not able to hold this as a spectator event.

Reducing the spread of COVID

Thank you for continuing to work with us to further reduce the spread of COVID-19. We know that you have been following the advice from the Director of Public Health and the Director of Education to do twice weekly Lateral Flow Tests.

Thank you to you all for your continued communication about your test results and symptoms too – we recognise you are all being incredibly vigilant. The number of cases is rising locally and we are acting to counteract this as much as possible with enhanced cleaning, ventilation and good hand hygiene practices. The whole school will be disinfected in the coming days with an Antiviral Fogging process to ensure we are keeping everyone safe.

I have updated our risk assessment for COVID-19 and this is available on our website. We are led by the guidance from Public Health and I will update the risk assessment when the situation changes. Currently, if you are entering the school site and in particular the school building I ask that you wear a face covering unless you are exempt. Staff are wearing face coverings again in corridors and communal spaces, as are external visitors to the school.

COVID Testing – for your January return

Please ensure your child has a negative test before the return to school in January. The children return to school on Wednesday 5th January and we are taking advice from Essex County Council – Education & Health to enable us to have the safest return. We ask for your continued cooperation with this. I have attached the letter from the council to all families.

Have a super week everyone and I look forward to seeing, and hearing many of you sing, at the Christmas Concert. Dress warm!
