Dear families,

We are loving the Christmas hats that we can see running around outside while the children do their Santa Fun Run! I have kept the timetable in for you this week.

### The School Expansion Plan – Exciting News

We have been granted planning permission to start our very exciting expansion where the school will be growing from one and a half classes per year group, to two classes in each year group. The first phase of the plan will start in February – whereby we will be having a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) installed on the field.

I will keep you all updated about the expansion plan in the newsletter. In the Spring Term we will be inviting you to attend a Zoom session whereby you can hear about the expansion in more detail; I'm sure you will all have some questions.

#### Reducing the spread of COVID

Thank you for continuing to work with us to reduce the transmission of COVID-19 variants. We know that you continue to follow the advice and guidance to do twice weekly Lateral Flow Tests and book a test if your child is symptomatic.

We are implementing our measures to reduce the transmission and have taken steps above and beyond the recommended guidance to further ensure the safety of everyone.

I have updated our risk assessment for COVID-19 and this is available on our website. We are led by the guidance from Public Health and I will update you as the situation develops within the school.

COVID Testing – for your January return

Please ensure your child has a negative test before the return to school in January. The children return to school on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January and we are taking advice from Essex County Council – Education & Health to enable us to have the safest return. We ask for your continued cooperation with this. I have attached the letter from the council to all families.
