Reducing the spread of COVID

Thank you for continuing to work with us to further reduce the spread of COVID-19. I am meeting with the Director of Public Health and the Director of Education on Wednesday to ensure we are up to date and are taking the best preventative, precautionary measures to keep everyone here at Trinity Road safe.

Thank you to you all for your continued efforts to prevent further transmission and your communications around your testing and symptoms. This really helps us to work together to ensure everyone is safe.

Currently if you are entering the school site, and in particular the school building, I ask that you wear a face covering, unless you are exempt. Furthermore, when you are entering the school building please ensure you have a negative Lateral Flow Test prior to this. This will also be the expectation for the upcoming Learner Conferences if you are booking a face to face meeting.

COVID Testing – follow the guidelines

The guidelines for testing has changed a number of times since late December and through the New Year. We are taking advice from Essex County Council – Education & Health, in addition to the government's latest guidance. Please follow the guidelines for testing from Day 6 if your child has tested positive and then ensure they return to school as soon as they have had two consecutive negative lateral flow tests, 24 hours apart.

Have a super week everyone and I am looking forward to seeing the new topic learning take shape across the school as all the children embark on their brilliant beginnings for their Spring Term learning!
