On Friday 4th February 2022, we will be having Number Day at Trinity Road Primary School. This is a fun day full of maths activities and challenges for your child to take part in, all in the name of raising some money for the NSPCC.

Every year, the **NSPCC** hold **Number Day** to help raise awareness of the children and families that need some support to help keep them safe. As a school, we will be taking part in the festivities to help raise money to donate to the **NSPCC**.


