The School Expansion Plan – Our Growing School

Some of you are keen to know when the new MUGA is being installed on the field and what is happening with the expansion plans for the school. The school was expecting the MUGA works to commence from February half term, but this has been delayed slightly and we are hoping this work will be commencing soon.

The expansion of the school is taking place in three phases;

Phase 1: MUGA on the field

Phase 2: New Lunch Bar Building

Phase 3: Reception Remodelling

It has always been the intention of the school to ensure that the phase 2 remodelling happens during the summer holidays. This is because the old lunch bar will be demolished and we need to ensure this happens when the children are not in school. Following this, the rebuilding of our new facility (including a new kitchen, hall and classrooms) will be taking place throughout the summer holidays and new autumn term.

Plans are already underway to link our exciting new expansion project with the children's learning. As the works commence, I will let you know how it is going and inform you about the changes that will be taking place to support the school run smoothly during the project. If you have any questions in the meantime, please come and ask me. Moving forward, I will be booking in some face to face and online events to share more information and answer any questions you have.
