Living with COVID

As we know, there are changes that are being introduced to the rules and regulations around COVID.

- Twice weekly asymptomatic testing guidance has been lifted as of today for all settings ***except*** *for special schools, AP and specialist SEND units in mainstream schools including specialist FE SEND provision*
- If someone under the age of 18 tests positive they will be advised to stay at home, this is the same advice for all adults – this will be reviewed on the 1st April.-
- Free testing will end from April 1 for the general public, including those with symptoms
- The government will continue to provide free tests for symptomatic people for the oldest age groups and those who are most vulnerable.

As a school we will still be practicing the preventative measures, such as good hand hygiene and ventilation, as routine practice. Hand sanitiser is available for staff and children to use should they wish to and masks are worn as a personal preference.

It was lovely to start this term with a whole school assembly, as our rates and cases in school have dropped significantly are we are able to assemble. We currently have no cases. Going forward we know that this will not always be the case and we will take appropriate guidance and steps, should we need to reintroduce any further preventative measures – this will be part of our internal risk assessment.
