Expansion Build News – Start Date and Changes

The expansion project is well underway, with the construction team on site daily now. This week all the utilities are being connected and the larger items will be fitted in the temporary kitchen on Monday 5th December. The on-site catering team will be cooking in there from Tuesday 6th December. The menu has been adapted to the changes in space – we will lose our gas hobs and will be replacing them with economy

saving induction units.

New School Entrance/Exit – From Monday 5th December

Where do I go next?

When you get inside the gates, TURN LEFT and follow the pathway, you will then be on the top playground.



Remember to give yourself enough time to get in to school on Monday 5th December with the changes in your journey.

At home time, enter into the school site through the same gates to collect your child.

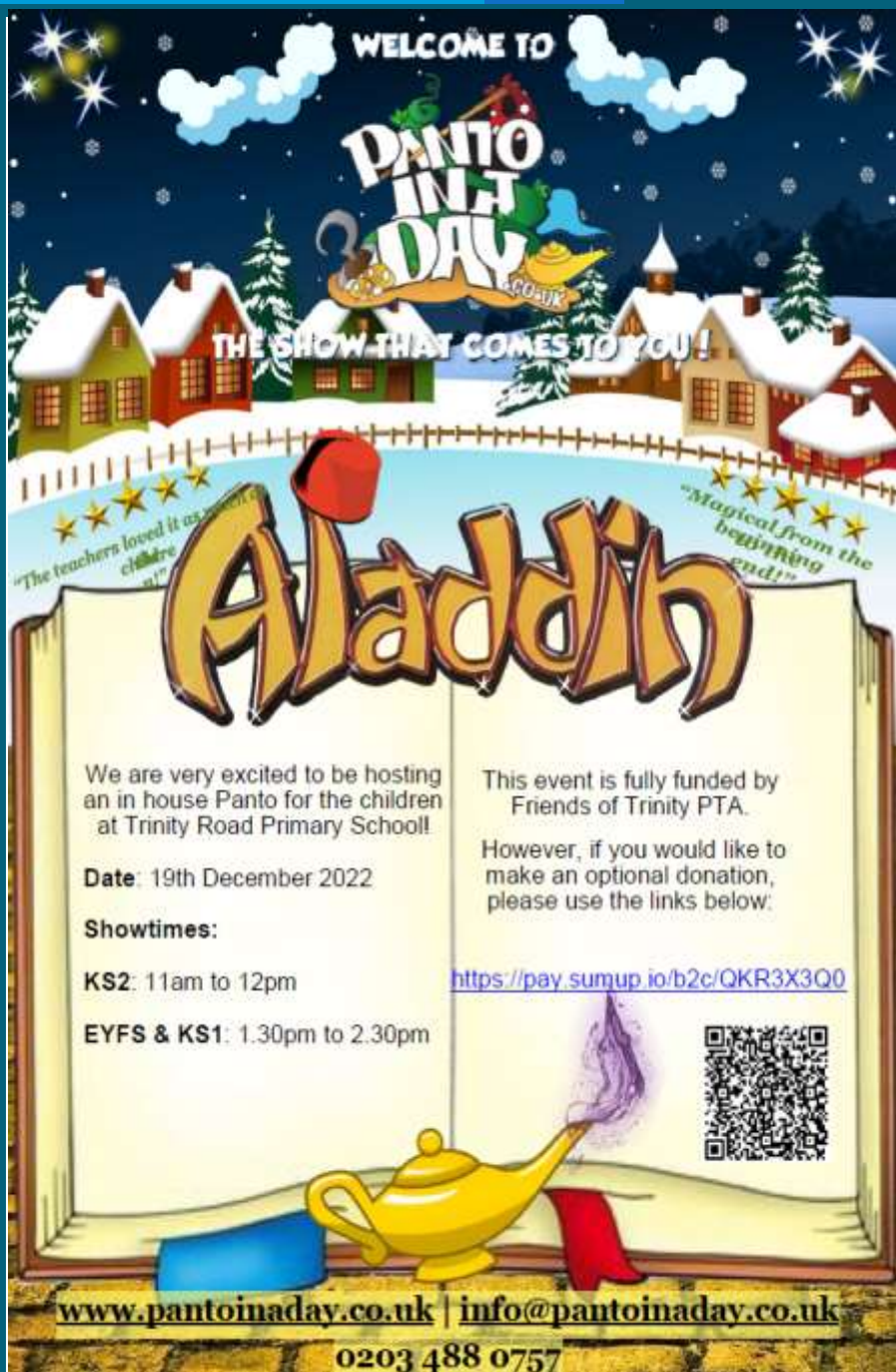
